The Children in Care Council (CiCC) is made up of young people aged 13-19 who are in care or are care leavers.

They are supported at their meetings by Nottingham City Council (NCC) staff that are referred to as Children in Care Council Officers and Champions.

The group meet a minimum of once a month.

At their meetings they look at local and national topics that impact on children in care (CiC) and Care Leavers (CLs).

The CiCC work helps shape or change the way CiC and CLs are supported by the Local Authority as corporate parents.

The work of the CiCC is reported to the Corporate Parenting Board (CPB), a member of the CiCC also sits on the CPB as a member.

Members of the CiCC also help out on interview and tendering panels .

The CiCC also have the opportunity to attend residential group weekends to complete work and team build.
